Tamblyn is named after the Willson family's ancestors who migrated to Australia from Cornwall.

TASTING NOTE

The Tamblyn blend expresses the characteristics of the different varietals, producing a complex flavour profile with a soft tannin finish; Cabernet Sauvignon provides the framework, Shiraz adds berry fruit weight, Malbec adds a perfumed lift and intense colour and the Merlot rounds out the palate. 48% Cabernet Sauvignon, 39% Shiraz, 7% Malbec and 6% Merlot.

VINIFICATION DETAILS

The components for Tamblyn were individually fermented in open top fermenters which allowed for optimal extraction of colour and flavour. The wine was matured in a combination of new and old French and American barrels for 18 months before blending and bottling.
