TASTING NOTE

This wine shows the pure varietal expression of Langhorne Creek Cabernet, one of the original red varietals that established the region. It displays a classic ripe cassis aroma with supportive savoury notes. A well-balanced palate showing ripe dark fruits is enhanced by a silky textural finish.

VINIFICATION DETAILS

Individual Cabernet parcels were fermented separately in small open fermenters to allow excellent extraction of colour and flavour. Each batch was matured in a combination of new and older French and American oak barriques for 18 months. The best individual parcels and barrels were selected to create the Coulthard Cabernet Sauvignon.

GREEN CREDENTIALS
