CORIOLE

Lloyd Reserve Shiraz is produced from a single vineyard at Coriole that was planted in 1919 and the first wine released in 1989.

TASTING NOTE

Luscious and layered aromas of black fruit, roasted spices, dark chocolate and a subtle note of marzipan. The palate is deliciously complex with intense fruit; plum, boysenberry and rhubarb. An elegant wine with great balance and restrained use of oak.

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

The 2014 vintage was locally described as the holiday vintage; ripening was slow and the estate tell us they had plenty of time to do what they wanted whenever they wanted! The wines turned out very well with plenty of colour, savour and richness along with characteristic Coriole restraint.

VINIFICATION DETAILS

Lloyd Reserve Shiraz is produced from a single vineyard at Coriole, planted in 1919, with the first wine released in 1989. The soil and roots are extremely deep with generally no irrigation required. The wine is matured in French oak for approximately 18 months and then receives 18+ months in bottle before release.
