


THE VIOLINIST VERDELHO, MOLLYDOOKER

TASTING NOTE

Verdelho is no exception to it's past. Aromas of pineapple and lychee combine with vanilla to create a creamy mouth-feel that is reminiscent of the French Oak it is aged in. Toasty coconut and hints of honeysuckle linger on the palate creating a long and seamless finish.

VINIFICATION DETAILS

Grapes were machine harvested at night at ideal flavour ripeness. Two thirds of the blend was fermented and matured in American oak, one-third in new French oak.
