

SAUVIGNON BLANC, WAIPARA SPRINGS

Waipara Springs' Sauvignon Blanc comes from estate-grown fruit from vines planted in 1992 as well as from their younger Church Road block.

TASTING NOTE

This Sauvignon Blanc displays punchy flavours of tropical fruit with vibrant minerality and notes of lemon zest, lime, melon and nettle. The palate is lively and crisp, with great depth and intensity. A blend of 96% Sauvignon Blanc, 4% Pinot Gris.

VINIFICATION DETAILS

Fruit was machine harvested from the estate's mature vines. Upon arrival at winery, pressed to tanks to settle overnight, then the clear juice was racked to stainless-steel tanks where it was fermented with a range of yeasts. Blended at the end of winter and bottled after a few months' resting on light lees, then filtration.
