



Better known as a variety in the great wines of Tokaji, at Lemberg Hárslevelü produces a dry white wine from vines planted in 1983.

TASTING NOTE

White flowers, peach and spice follow through on the textured, fresh palate with great length. The wine has a lingering, fresh, vibrant and lively acidity.

VINIFICATION DETAILS

Made in a more natural, minimalistic and more oxidative style and approach, the components are expressed in an old-world style and come to their full potential. 500 L French oak barrels were used to age the wine for 10 months.
