TASTING NOTE

This single vineyard Shiraz sourced from the Rolf Binder Estate on the Barossa's Western Ridge sub region, really shows off the richness of old vine Barossa Shiraz. medium to full-bodied wine with a deep purple colour. The nose is expressive, with aromas of dark plum, blackberry, liquorice, vanillin cedar, subtle earthy dark chocolate and spice. The palate is rich, silky and layered with plush dark fruits. The tannins are cashmere-like and the finish is long, sleek and deeply fruited.

VINTAGE CONDITIONS


The 2021 vintage in the Barossa Valley is widely regarded as one of the best in recent years. The cool, wet growing season produced wines with great concentration of flavours, balanced acidity, and fine tannins. Shiraz was the star of the show, with wines that are full-bodied and complex, yet also elegant and refined.

VINIFICATION DETAILS

The grapes are hand and machine harvested. Each parcel of grapes crushed and fermented in open fermenters. The fermentation is completed in tank before the wine is racked to barrel. The wine is aged in a selection of older (6yr) French and American oak for 16 months before blending and bottling.
