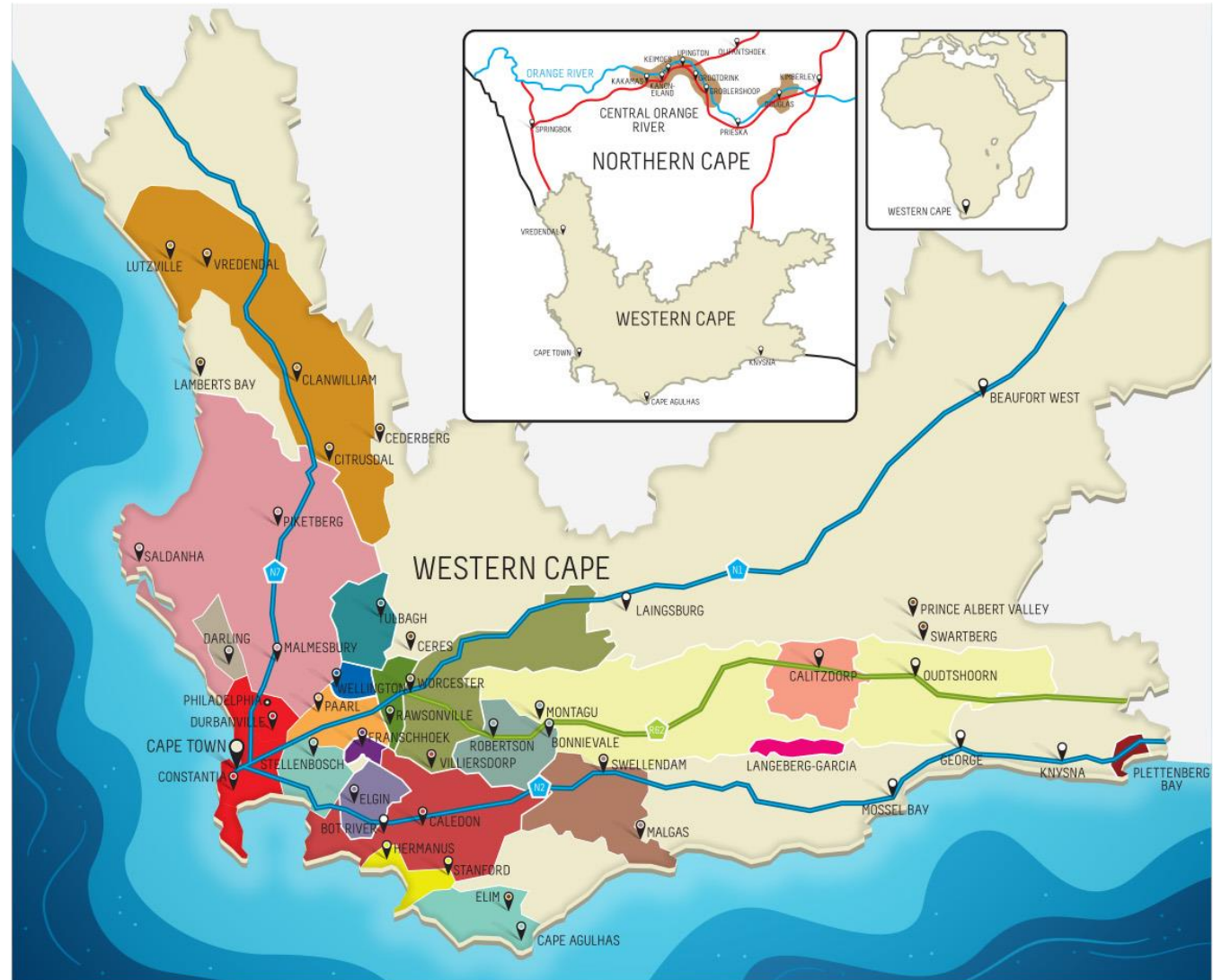

4th Generation Family Owned Wine business

- The farm, situated in the Bottelary Hills ward of Stellenbosch, Western Cape, was purchased by the Steytler Family in 1946 and is now managed by the 4th Generation son, Danie Jnr and his wife Carin Steytler.
- The Kaapzicht brand is 2nd generation, as it was only in 1984 that Danie Snr and wife Yngvild took the decision to break away from selling their fruit to the co-operative in the area, Stellenbosch Farmers Winery.
- The name Kaapzicht translates to Cape View (Kaap meaning Cape and Zicht meaning View or sight in German) from the top of the farm, one looks over the Table Mountain and City of Cape Town.
- Yngvild Steytler is of German decent and when writing down the name to trade mark translated 'sight' into German being 'ZICHT'.



How it all began..

- Danie Snr & Yngvild Steytler successfully built the Kaapzicht brand into a much respected family wine business between 1984 – 2015.
- Danie Snr managed the wine making and Yngvild the export market for sales.
- Both Danie Snr and Yngvild retired at the end of 2021.



Looking forward..

- Danie Jnr joined his father in the cellar in 2009 after travelling abroad for 5 years making wine in various countries.
- In 2015, Danie Jnr began managing the cellar and the business and Carin joined the Company to manage local sales.
- Danie Jnr and his wife Carin assumed full ownership of the Kaapzicht brand in February 2022.



The Future

- Danie & Carin have two Children, Klein Danie & Mieke
- The Vision is to continue building on the strong foundation of the current brand whilst adapting with the times to keep the brand exciting and to one day hand over to the 5th Generation.



Vineyard breakdown

- 200 hectares in size
- 130 hectares under vine
 - 70% planted to red grape varieties
 - Cabernet Sauvignon
 - Pinotage
 - Shiraz
 - Merlot
 - 30% planted to white grape varieties
 - 70% planted to Chenin Blanc

Portfolio

- The main focus is on the production of Chenin Blanc & Pinotage.
- The portfolio is divided into three ranges, each range showcasing an expression of those two varieties.
 - The Family Range
 - Highest production, most affordable
 - Fermentation in stainless steel, first wines to be bottled and released after harvest.
 - The Terroir Range
 - Focusing on specific blocks on the farm
 - All wines are matured in barrel for a minimum period of 10 months up to 20 months, pending on the wine.
 - The Steytler Range
 - Smaller production with only 1800 bottles produced of the Chenin blanc per annum and 6000 bottles of the reds, only produced in exceptional vintages.
